



Norms Followed For Fixing Fee

- Ensuring fees are commensurate with infrastructure, facilities, and staff salaries.
- The process considers the parent's capacity to pay, school operating costs, and requires approval from the School Management Committee.

Key norms followed for fixing fees:

- Government/Board Guidelines: Adherence to CBSE bylaws and state government regulations regarding fee regulation.

Operating Expenditure:

- Expenses for staff salaries, maintenance, security, and learning aids.

Infrastructure & Facilities:

- Fees are tailored to the quality of facilities and technology provided.

Parental Capacity:

- Consideration of the economic conditions of parents and community feedback.

Annual Review:

- Fees are reviewed annually by the school management committee, with no mid-session hikes.

Non-Profit Principle:

- Ensuring the fee structure reflects the institution's nature as non-profit and educational.

Common Factors Considered:

- Staff salary and recruitment expenses School reserve and contingency funds Sports, library, lab, and technology facilities (CCTV, Computer) School infrastructure development and renovation.

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
